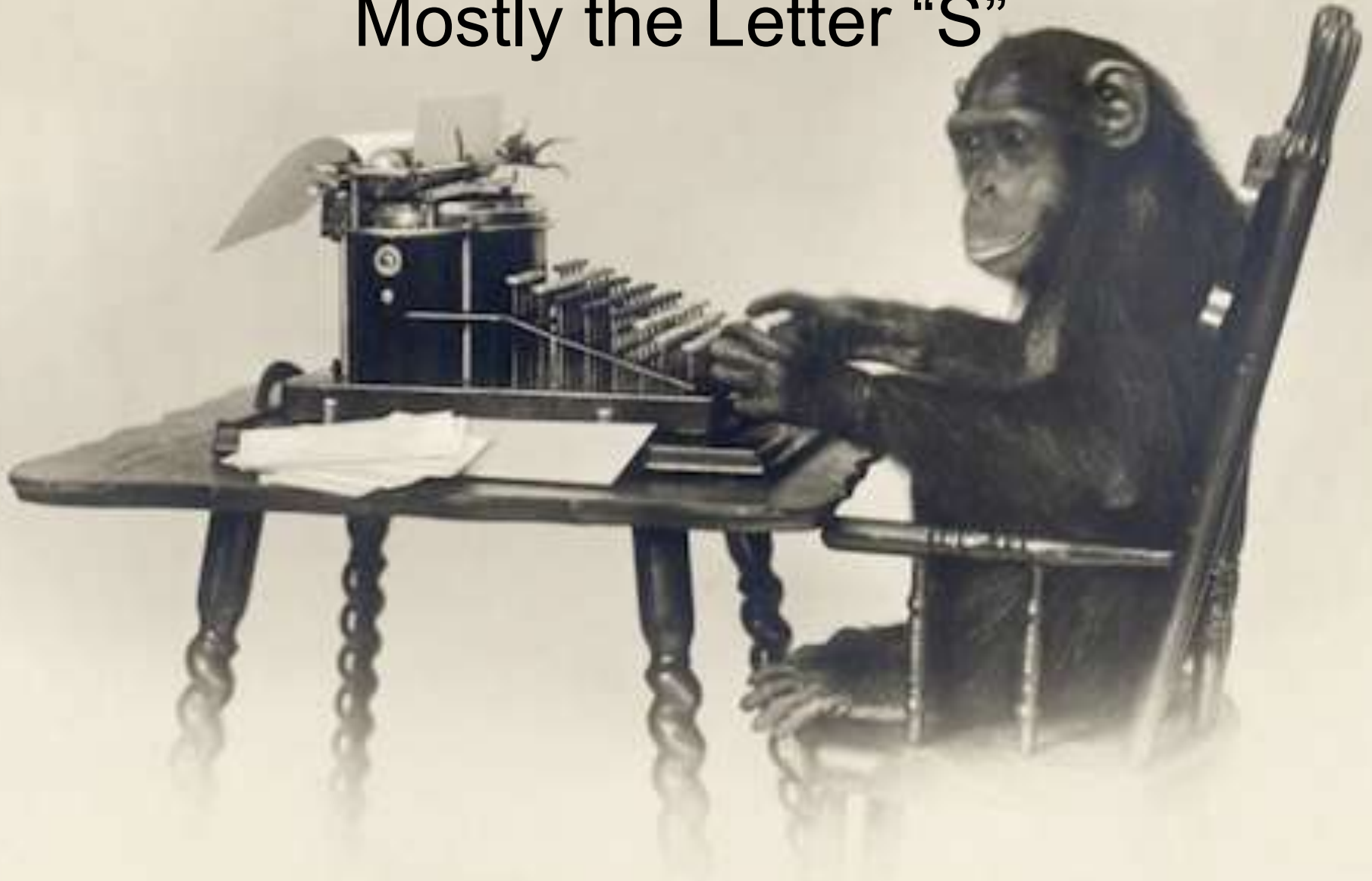






# Plymouth Experiment –
