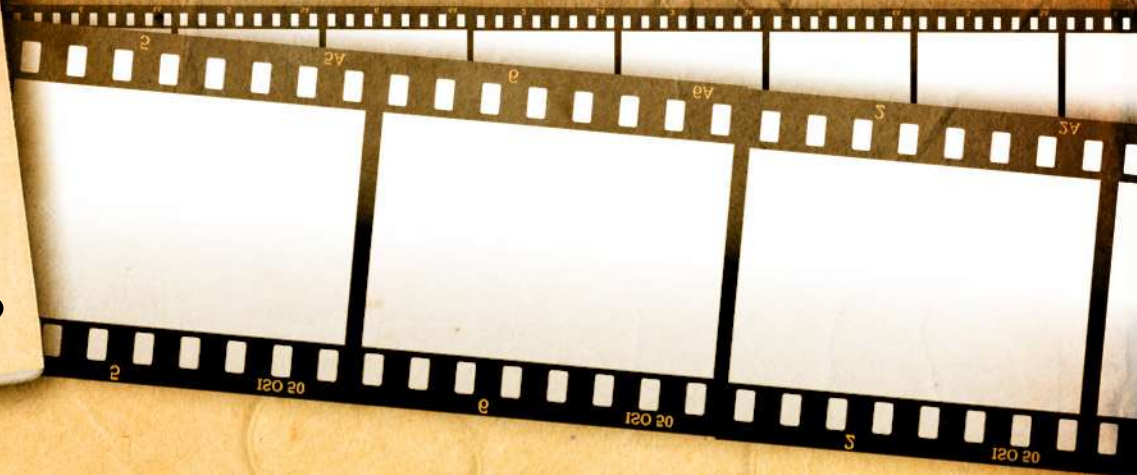




Abraham
Overcame.



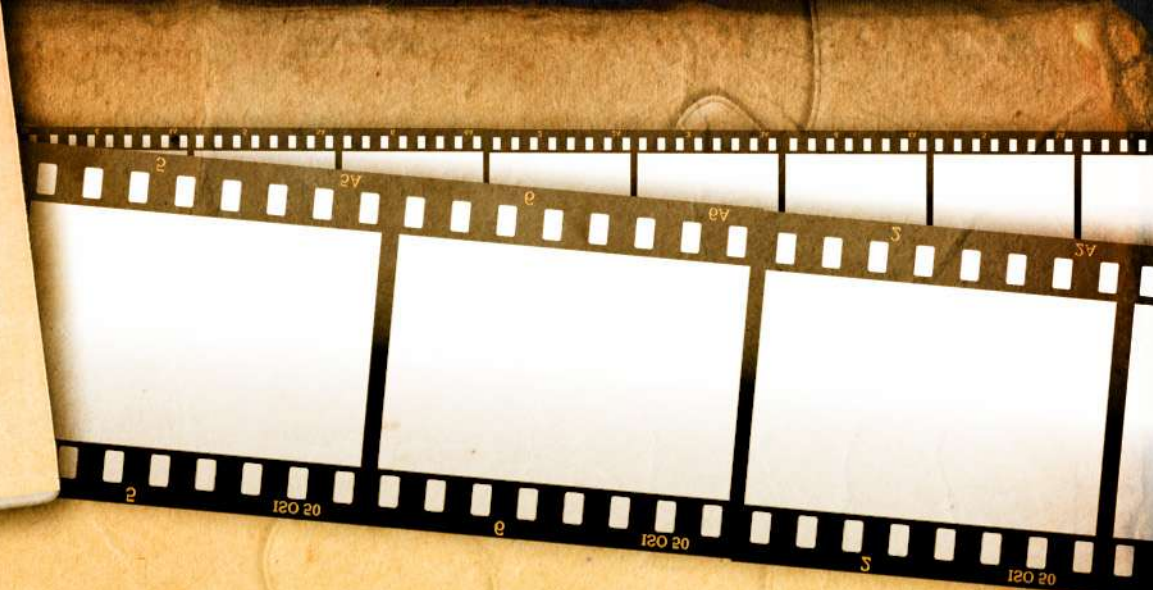
