John 19:28-30

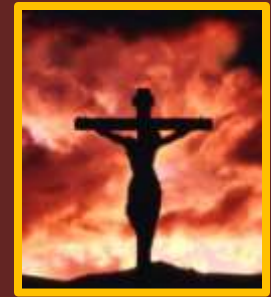
