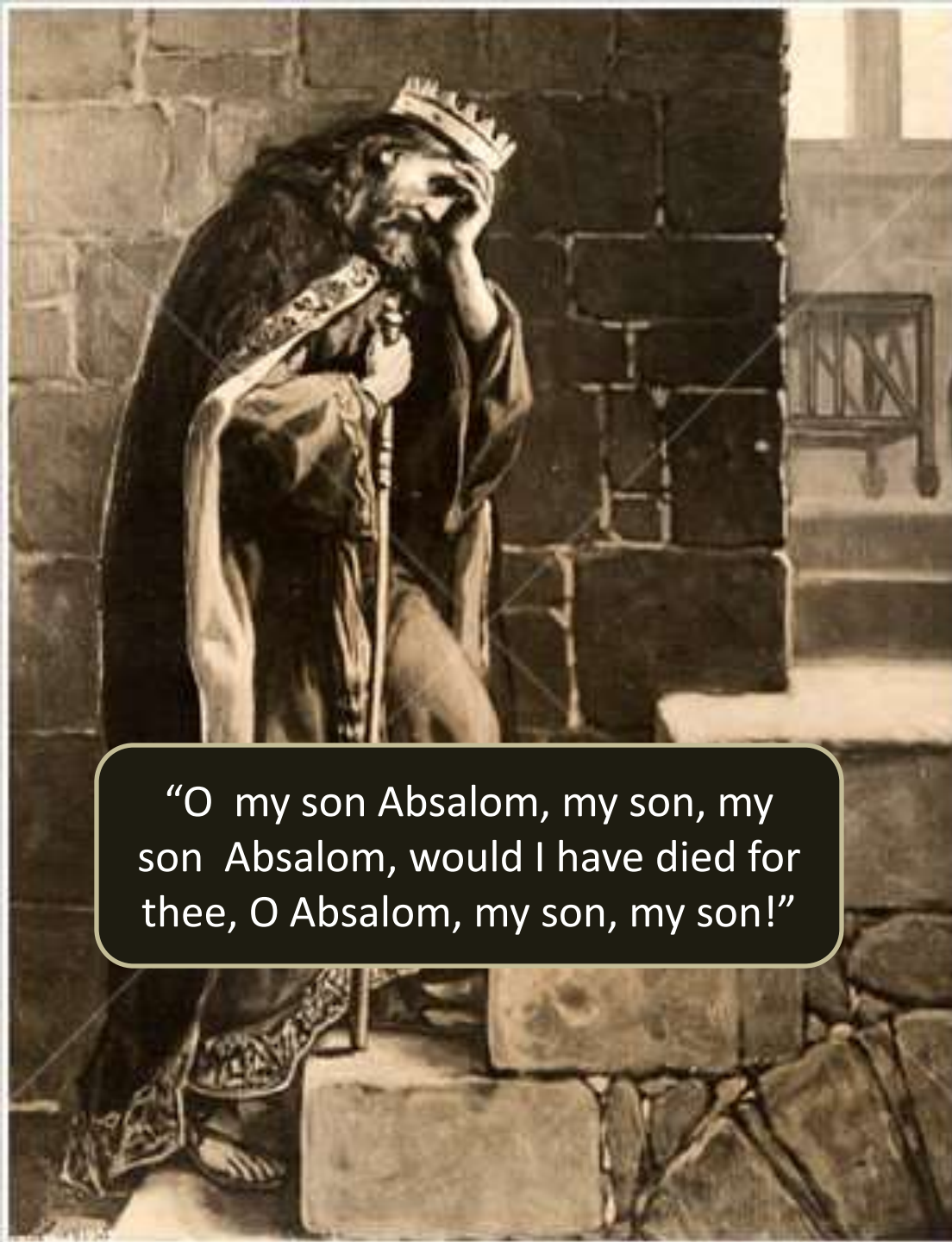
2 Samuel 14 - 18
