## We like being comfortable.







Galatians 2:20 - I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me.

## There are three appeals to the comfortable:

Jeremiah appeals to conscience, vss. 3-7.

**Isaiah 28:15** 15 Because you have said, "We have made a covenant with death, And with Sheol we have made a pact. The overwhelming scourge will not reach us when it passes by, For we have made falsehood our refuge and we have concealed ourselves with deception."

The people are on thin ice because of their behavior.


Hebrews 5:14

They tear up the 10 Commandments and then turn up at church.


**Matthew 15:7-9**
