



Walk in Light

Ephesians 5:8-14

It's a Present Walk

- Frozen: "I'm never going back, the past is in the past"
- Paul affirmed to the Ephesians they were once in darkness, but now they were walking as children of light
 - If you are now in the light, it doesn't matter how dark of a past you had
 - The Apostle Paul (Phil. 3:13-14; 1 Cor. 15:9; Acts 26:9-11)
 - The Corinthian Christians (1 Cor. 6:9-11)

It's a Pleasing Walk

- When we are doing something for someone else, we want to please them:
 - Marriage
 - Work
- Paul told the Ephesians they were trying to learn what was pleasing to the Lord
 - Notice the contrast between darkness and light
 - The things of darkness are unfruitful, disgraceful and secretive
 - The fruit of the light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth

It's a Pleasing Walk

- Deeds of darkness:
 - Unfruitful (Jn. 15:6)
 - Disgraceful (1 Cor. 11:4-6)
 - Secretive (1 Thess. 5:7)
- Fruit of the light:
 - Fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23)
 - Wisdom from above is full of good fruits (Jas. 3:17)
 - The way to bear much fruit is to stay connected to the vine (Jn. 15:5)

It's a Pleasing Walk

- We want to be like Christ:
 - "I always do the things that are pleasing to Him" (Jn. 8:29)
- The light exposes the things of the darkness:
 - Jn. 3:16-21

It's a Protected Walk

- Some things in life protect us some of the time
 - Umbrellas
 - Sunblock
- We are protected spiritually if we walk in the light
 - 1 Jn. 1:5-10

It's a Protected Walk

- We have continual cleansing from the blood of Jesus if we are walking in the light and if we are confessing our sins
- How do you harmonize this passage with 1
 Jn. 3:5-6?
 - How can we commit sin but there be no sin in Christ?

It's a Protected Walk

We have total protection through the blood of Christ:

-SIN

-PROOF

-FACTOR
