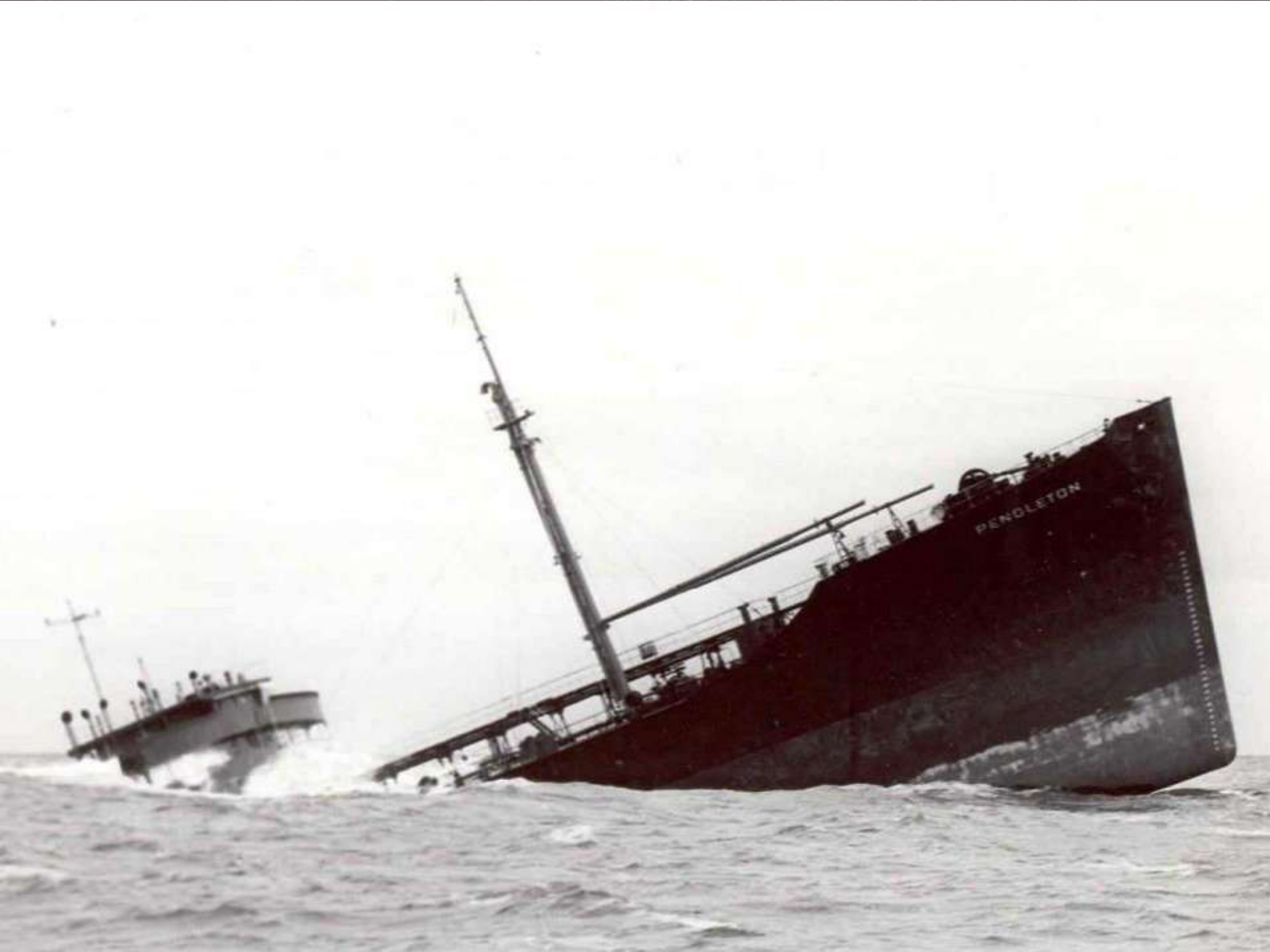

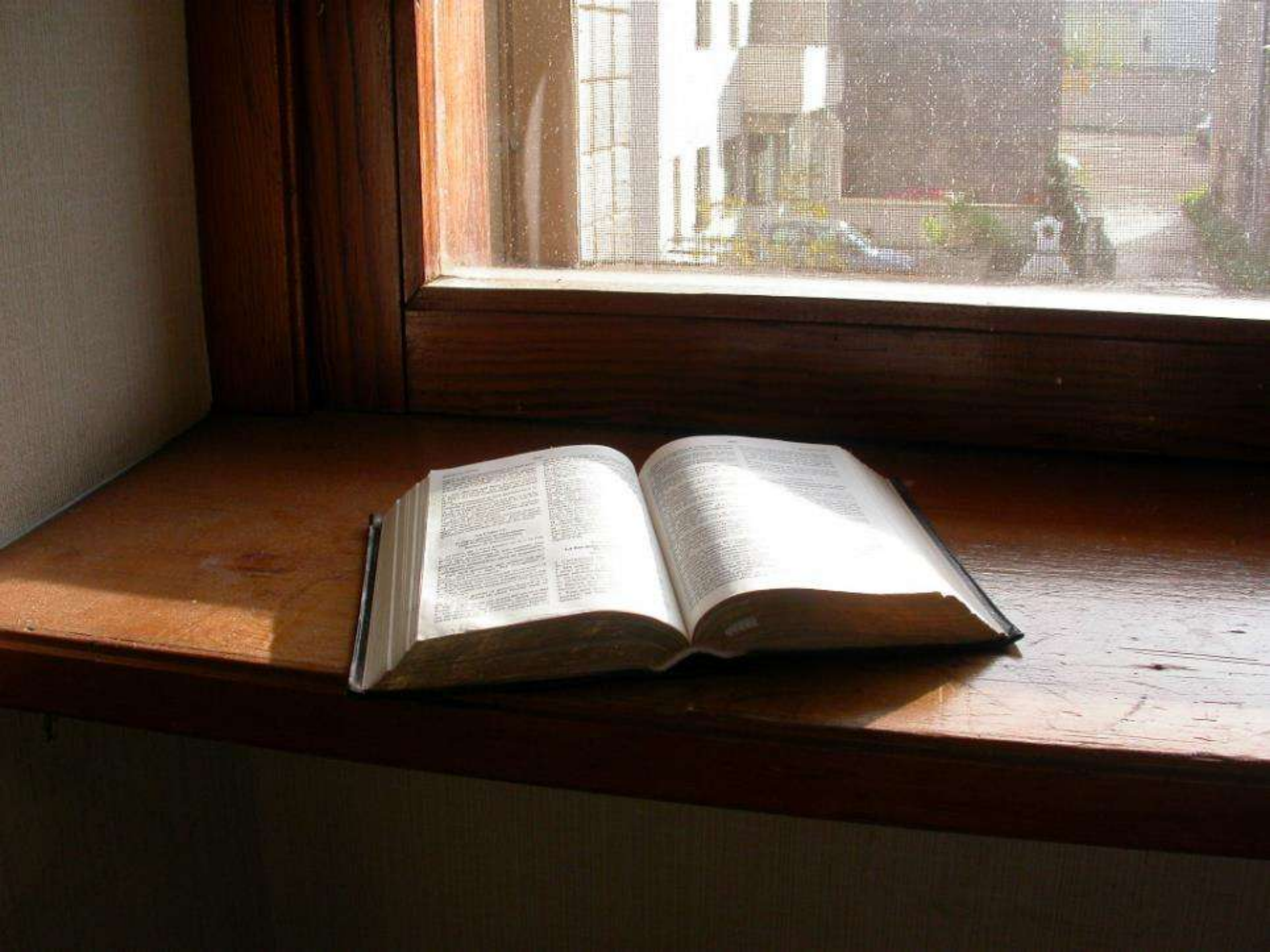

Romans 5:8 - But Christ shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.


Sacrifice
