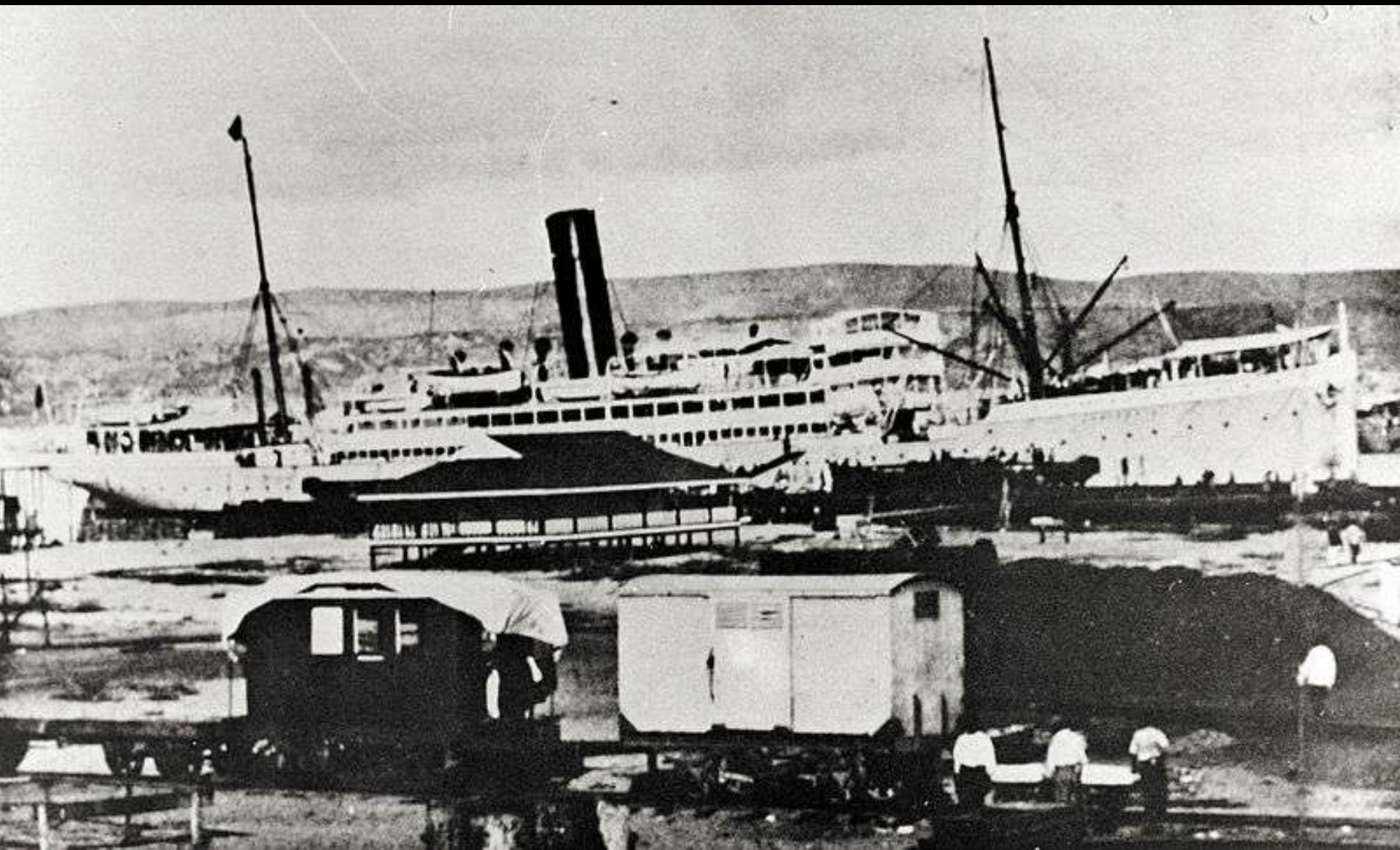






Emptying the Net




