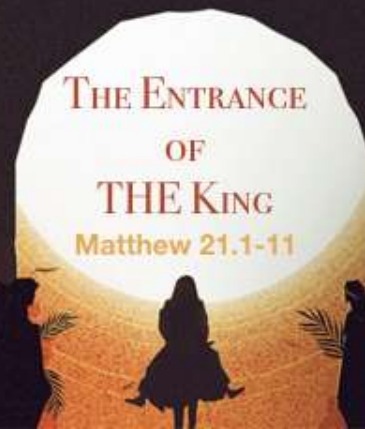

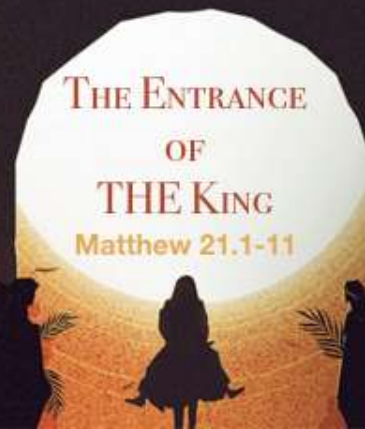
EXALTATION

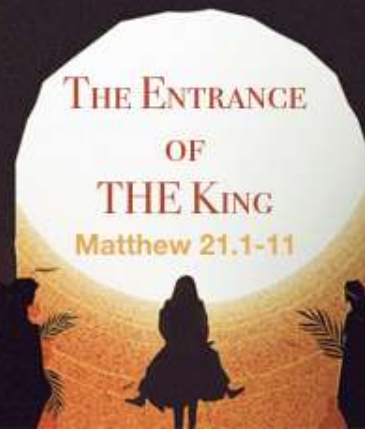

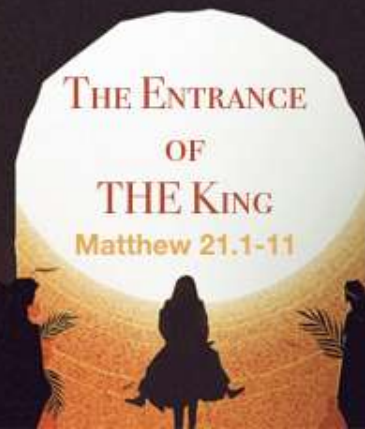

They spoke to them just as Jesus had told them, and they gave them permission.

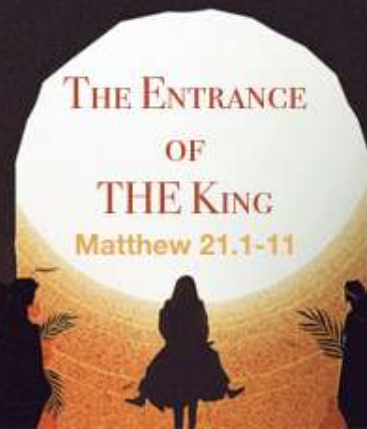
