17 But in giving this instruction, I do not praise you, because you come together not for the better but for the worse. **18** For, in the first place, when you come together as a church, I hear that divisions exist among you; and in part I believe it. **19** For there must also be factions among you, so that those who are approved

may become evident among you. **20**
Therefore when you meet together, it is not to
eat the Lord's Supper, **21** for in your eating
each one takes his own supper first; and one is
hungry and another is drunk. **22** What! Do you
not have houses in which to eat and drink? Or
do you despise the church of God and shame

those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you? In this I will not praise you. **23** For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; **24** and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “This is My body, which is for

you; do this in remembrance of Me.” **25** In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” **26** For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes. **27** Therefore

whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. **28** But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. **29** For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the

body rightly. **30** For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. **31** But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. **32** But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world. **33** So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat,

wait for one another. **34** If anyone is hungry, let him eat at home, so that you will not come together for judgment. The remaining matters I will arrange when I come.
