## **Acts 8:25-40**

**25** So, when they had solemnly testified and spoken the word of the Lord, they started back to Jerusalem, and were preaching the gospel to many villages of the Samaritans. **26** But an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip saying, “Get up

and go south to the road that descends from Jerusalem to Gaza.” (This is a desert road.) **27** So he got up and went; and there was an Ethiopian eunuch, a court official of Candace, queen of the Ethiopians, who was in charge of all her treasure; and he had

come to Jerusalem to worship, **28** and he was returning and sitting in his chariot, and was reading the prophet Isaiah. **29** Then the Spirit said to Philip, “Go up and join this chariot.” **30** Philip ran up and heard him reading Isaiah the prophet, and said, “Do you understand

what you are reading?” **31** And he said, “Well, how could I, unless someone guides me?” And he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. **32** Now the passage of Scripture which he was reading was this: “He was led as a sheep to slaughter; And as a lamb

before its shearer is silent, So He does not open His mouth. **33** In humiliation His judgment was taken away; Who will relate His generation? For His life is removed from the earth.” **34** The eunuch answered Philip and said, “Please tell me, of whom does the



prophet say this? Of himself or of someone else?” **35** Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him.
