
The Great Sphinx

- 66 Feet Tall




Moses

1. Moses Refused To
Sustain The Sinful.
(Hebrews 11:24-26)

2. Moses Left The Familiar. (Hebrews 11:27)




There is no sphinx for Moses in Egypt because Moses was more committed to God's plan than his own plan.
